



VALUE TARIFFS FOR **RECOVERABLE INERT WASTE** PRESENTED BY CUSTOMERS WITH OWN TRANSPORT AT OUR RECYCLING FACILITY GATE **FROM 1ST JUNE 2026 (UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE)**

Your onerous & mixed wastes presented at our facility need to be cleaned by us before meeting an acceptable standard for ongoing disposal at La Collette and/or other facilities, where we will need to transport & pay to dispose of such wastes. Onerous wastes are categorised/priced as to the amount of waste that is likely to be left over requiring disposal.

	N.B	At the discretion of the gate waste manager – To qualify, no fines, brick, tarmac, reinforced concrete, loose rebar, glass, wood, plastic, plaster lathe, render, wallpaper, etc; and/or other contaminants, render, wallpaper etc
VERY CLEAN – STONE/CONCRETE £5.20 PER CUYD 85% RECOVERABLE	B	Very clean good quality 85% recoverable concrete block/stone cleaned demolition material
	N.B	At the discretion of the gate waste manager – To qualify, no ceramic, brick, slates, tarmac, reinforced concrete, loose rebar, clay, clay fines, glass, minor wood, render, wallpaper, etc; and/or other contaminants.
CAT 1 – CLEAN SOILS/SANDS £9.36 PER CUYD	A	Clean white sand loads - good quality. No stone or gravel under 15mm.
	B	Clean concrete loads with up to 20% cement fines.
CAT 1 – CLEAN STONE/CONCRETE £11.44 PER CUYD MAINLY RECOVERABLE	C	Clean Topsoil or Black Sand Loads – Good Quality. No weeds, roots, clay or gravel stones/chippings.
	D	Clean concrete blocks or stones with over 20% cement/sand base fines (uncleaned demolition material)
	N.B	No ceramic, brick, slates, reinforced concrete, clay, clay fines, glass or minor wood &/or other contaminants.
CAT 2 – SOILS & SANDS £20.80 PER CUYD LOW VALUE RECOVERABILITY	A	Medium quality topsoil or black sand. Load can include large stones/clean concrete. No clay, weeds, roots, gravel or chippings under 15mm, as such renders soils as undesirable for resale.
	B	Clean tarmac loads. No concrete, stones, clay or contaminants - Excess warm tarmac loads.
CAT 2 – STONE/CONCRETE £31.20 PER CUYD A GOOD PERCENTAGE OF LOAD IS RECOVERABLE WITH A FAIR AMOUNT OF WASTE REMAINING FOR ONWARD DFI DISPOSAL	C	Inert loads where part of load remains a waste for onward disposal. Clean concrete loads including minimal small bar reinforced with up to 40% cement/sand base fines. No sub-soils.
	D	Clean large shale type loads. Minimal shale fines under 25mm. Minimal clay/subsoil fines up to 10%.
	E	Tarmac loads with or without other stone/concrete & minimal hoggin/gravel. No clay or other contaminants.
	F	Topsoil based loads mixed with large concrete/stone. No chipping's or gravel within load.
	G	Gravel/sand based fine loads with rubble. No clay/subsoil.
	N.B	No volume clay fines, slates, pan roof tiles, glass, ceramics, garden paving slabs, brick, heavy bar reinforced concrete, green waste, turf mix or *plasterboard
CAT 3 - INERT £41.60 PER CUYD MINOR PART OF LOAD IS RECYCLABLE WITH LOTS OF WASTE REMAINING FOR ONWARD DFI DISPOSAL	A	Rubble loads with minimal mixtures of clay, soil, sand, gravel with up to a total of 25% fines.
	B	Dry season shale loads with percentage of clay fines up to 25%.
	C	Loads with good recoverable quality topsoil. Load can include up to 20% stone or minimal clay and/or turf.
	D	Inert waste(s) having no significant recyclable value i.e. mainly clay type loads. Note: If, however, we deem that 50% of a load is recoverable, i.e., containing blocks or stone, then this recyclable price of £41.60 applies, if there is not 50% recovery, then the Cat 4 below price of £48.15 will apply for loads deemed as having little or no viable recyclability/or recoverability.
	N.B	No reinforced concrete, slates, tarmac, glass, ceramics, garden paving slabs, brick, look-a-like asbestos slate, volume turf/green waste or *plasterboard
CAT 4 – (DFI INERT TYPE LOADS) (AS DFI ACCEPTANCE) £48.15 PER CUYD CLEAN INERT BUT RECOVERY UNVIAIBLE	A	Rubble loads with minimal mixtures of clay, soil, sand, gravel with over 25% fines with very minimal traces of turf. (Please note in DFI's new waste criteria states that loads must now be of singular material of 'either' concrete, stones, paving slabs, brick or ceramics, not mixtures of such materials. Inert loads must not include any subsoils or clays otherwise they are likely to be rejected).
	B	Dry shale loads with over 25% clay fines - Any shale load in wet months.
	N.B	No *plasterboard, glass, tarmac, brick, slates or look-a-like asbestos slate, volume turf/green waste. No subsoil, sand, clay, shale loads or wet sloppy mud mixtures.
CAT 5 -INERT SOIL MIXTURES £62.40 PER CUYD	A	Wet soil/clay mixed with up to 20% clean stone or concrete. No tarmac, brick, slates and/or ceramics
	B	Clay/soil with medium amounts of turf, green waste and/or roots. Loads will need picking clean.

CAT 5 -INERT MIXTURES OF SOIL, TURF, CERAMICS (REQUIRES SORTING & CLEANING BEFORE TIP DISPOSAL) £72.80 PER CUYD INERT RECOVERY UNVAILABLE. REQUIRES SORTING BEFORE ONWARD DFI DISPOSAL	C	Builder's rubble with mixtures of minimal amounts of therma blocks, brick, tile, glass, and/or ceramics which also include minimal amounts of clay or soil. Please note that this higher charge applies as the main content of the load must be handpicked or sieved to clean the load before we incur the costs of reloading, transporting, and us paying for the unrecoverable waste at DFI £48.15 tip fee.
	D	Concrete loads with up to 30% heavy bar reinforced concrete / loads containing tarmac lumps.
CAT 6 - INERT MIXED (ONEROUS SORTING/CLEANING) £93.60 PER CUYD INERT RECOVERY UNVAILABLE	N.B	No look-a-like asbestos slate or *plasterboard.
	A	Mixed as described in Cat 5, but with any tarmac included and/or onerous or volume amounts of mixed glass, ceramics, turf, and/or other clay/soil included, which take considerable man/machine hours to deal with. Load consisting of mostly heavy bar reinforced concrete.
CAT 7 – INERT MIXED (MORE ONEROUS SORT/CLEANING)	N.B	No look-a-like asbestos slate or *plasterboard
	N.B	More onerous inert mixed wastes/ceramic loads - P.O.A per cuyd.
*PLASTERBOARD – CLEAN OR BACKED	ADDITIONAL/SUPPLEMENTARY CHARGES FOR ANY CLEAN OR CONTAMINATED PLASTERBOARD INCLUDED WITHIN ANY INERT OR MIXED WASTE LOAD BELOW

*PLASTERBOARD – CLEAN	Any calculated amount of clean plasterboard included within any inert or mixed waste load category will incur a supplementary charge for, segregation, re-transportation & disposal at DFI of £72.80 per 1/3 of a cuyd (approx. 1/3 of a 1-ton bag).
*PLASTERBOARD – CONTAMINATED	Any calculated amount of contaminated plasterboard (i.e. -plasterboard backed with foam insulation, silver paper, metal board with insulation, tiles or other contaminated backed plasterboard) included within any inert or mixed waste load category will incur a supplementary charge for, segregation, hand-stripping/cleaning, re-transportation & disposal at DFI of £104.00 per 1/3 of a cuyd (approx. 1/3 of a 1-ton bag).
*WEDI-BOARD	Any calculated amount of wedi-board included within any mixed waste load category will incur a supplementary charge for, segregation, hand-stripping/cleaning, re-transportation & disposal of £104.00 per 1/3 of a cuyd (approx. 1/3 of a 1-ton bag).
*LENGTHS OF ROPE OVER 1-METER	Any calculated amount of rope over 1m in length included within any mixed waste load category will incur a supplementary charge for, segregation, hand-cutting, re-transportation & disposal of £72.80 per 1/3 of a cuyd (approx. 1/3 of a 1-ton bag).
*METAL CLAD FLOOR TILES INCLUDED WITHIN LOADS	Any calculated amount of metal clad floor tiles included within any mixed waste load category will incur a supplementary charge for, segregation, hand-stripping, re-transportation & disposal of £104.00 per 1/3 of a cuyd (approx. 1/3 of a 1-ton bag).
*OTHER ONEROUS PRODUCTS/MATERIALS	POA – Price on application

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N.B. All category designations must NOT include any licensed or non-licensed asbestos board, asbestos roofing or lookalike asbestos roofing, as we cannot determine its toxicity or origin (nor can DFI). Loads containing such will be rejected and a reloading charge of £55.00 will be levied, or a charge be agreed with customers to rectify such contaminant. Please see our terms & conditions drop down page for rejected, reloading and other possible asbestos arising/contaminates charges.
